Each diagram shows:


1. The key signature

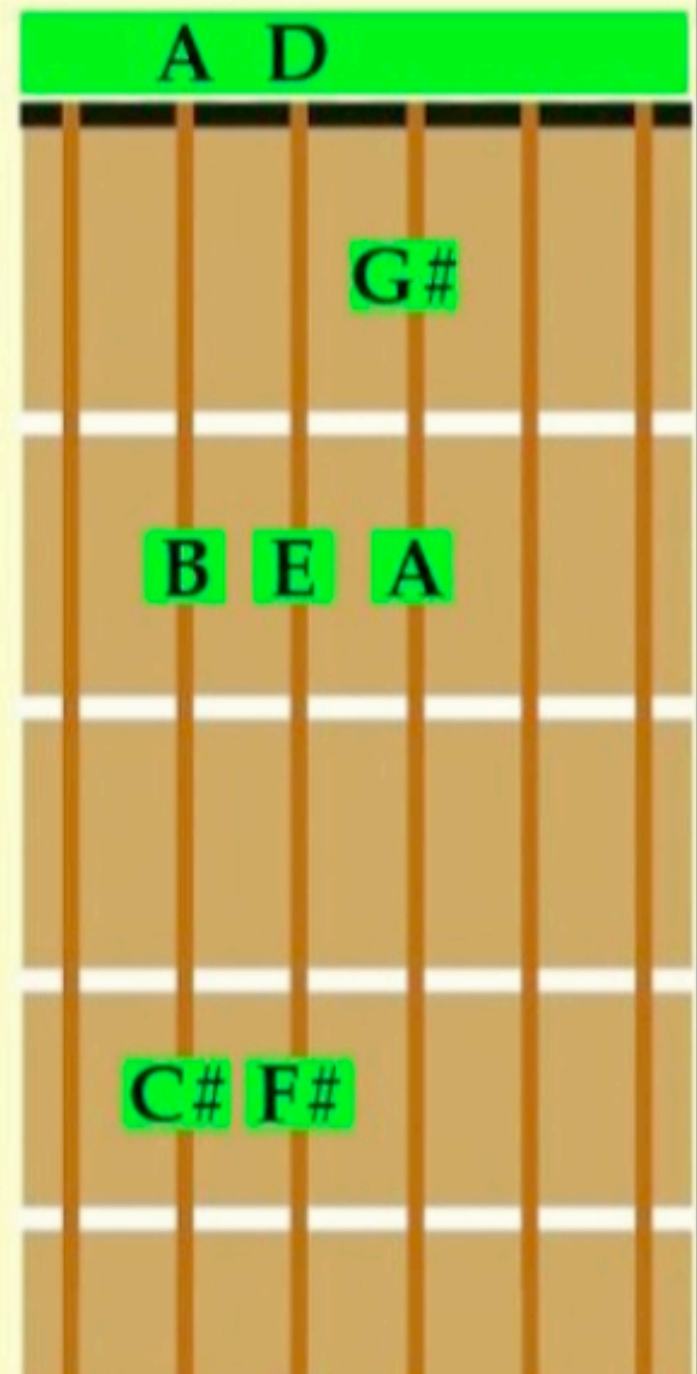

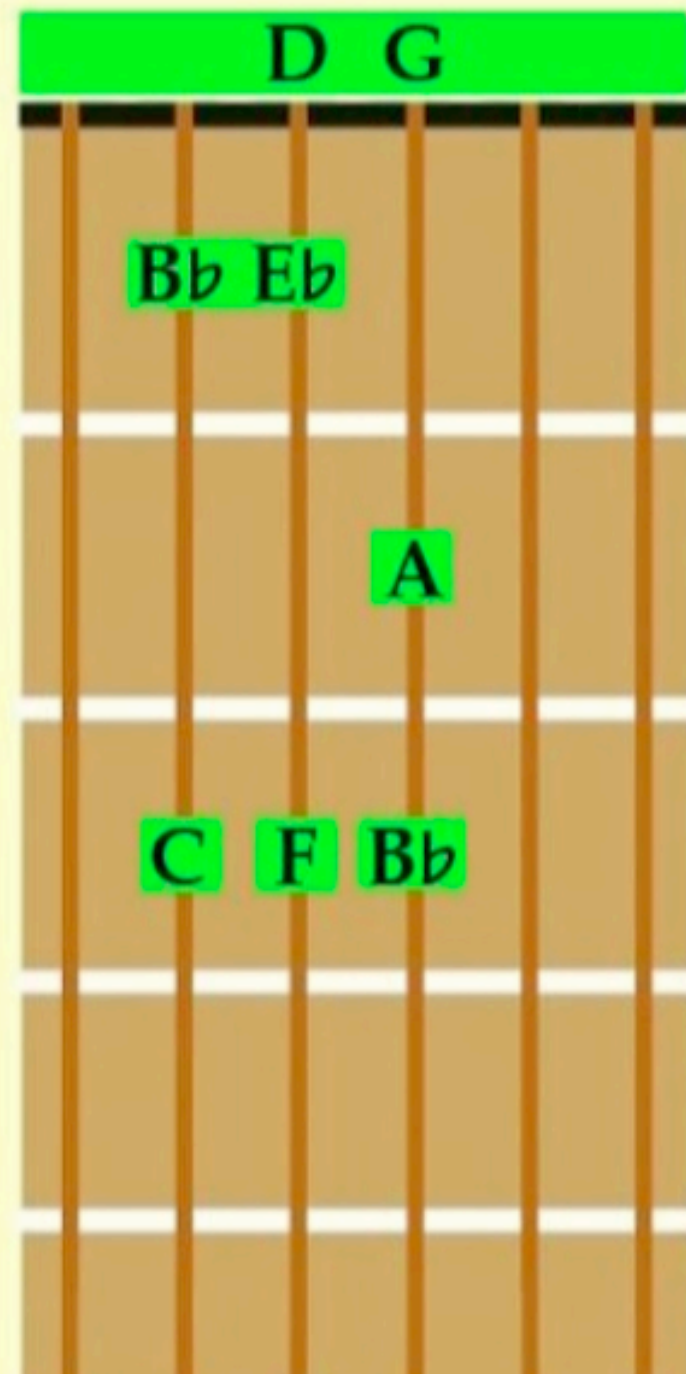
